Innovation grants for students attending *Measuring Behavior*

Noldus Innovation Technology is offering sponsorship for students from developing countries attending *Measuring Behavior 2010*. Grants will be awarded to the three students showing the most innovative use of software or equipment supplied by Noldus Information Technology.

The grant consists of up to €500 towards travel costs and a waiver of the conference fees. It does not include hotel costs or any other expenses.

To qualify for a grant you must meet the following criteria:

- Your presentation must describe work that is innovative in the field of measuring behavior.
- You must be an undergraduate or postgraduate student at a recognized educational institution.
- Your abstract must be accepted for the conference by the scientific program committee.
- You must be resident in a country that is not a member of the OECD.

Procedure

- Submit your abstract in the normal way.
- Mail the conference program chair (Andrew@measuringbehavior.org) that you wish to be considered for this grant, so that we can make sure that your abstract is reviewed promptly.
- After your abstract is accepted, mail the conference organization the following information:
 - a. Proof of student status (e.g. a letter from your head of department).
 - b. A brief explanation (less than one page) of why your work is innovative.
