

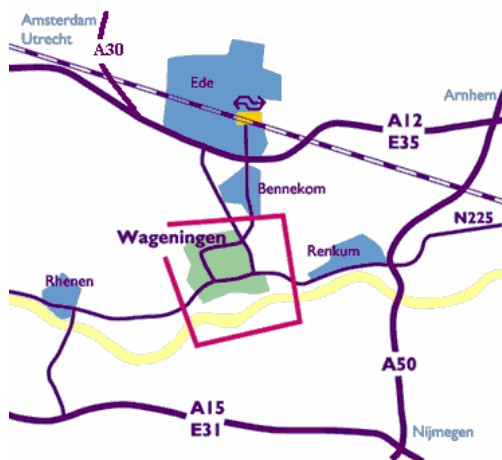
1. Location of Wageningen in the Netherlands



Map of the Netherlands (courtesy "East Side", Arnhem).

Wageningen is located in the centre of the country (indicated by the red polygon).

2. Location of Wageningen in the region

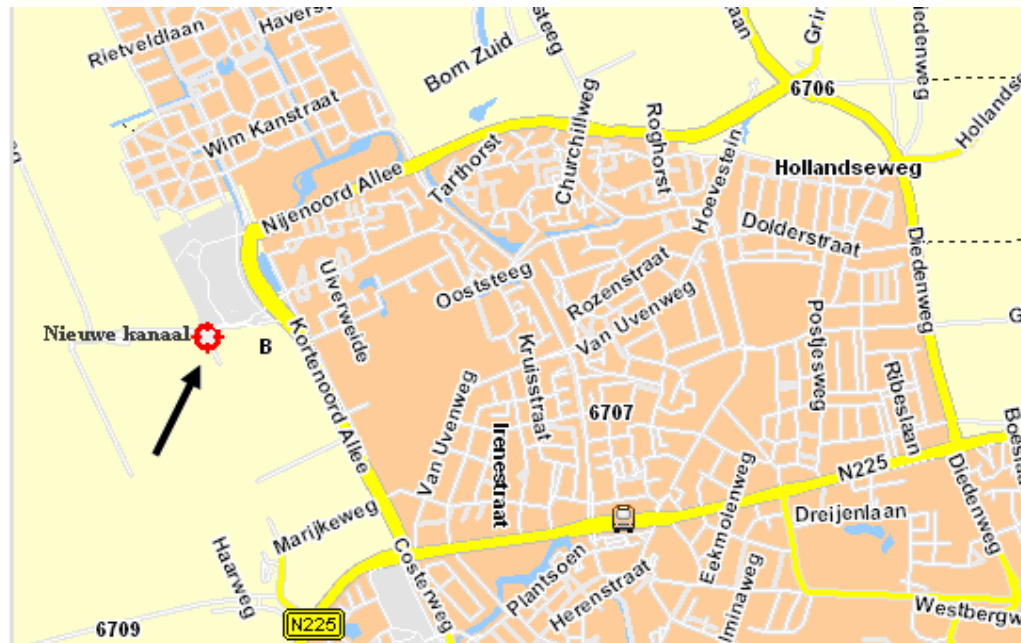


Map of the region around Wageningen (courtesy "East Side", Arnhem).

The map shows the location of Wageningen relative to the nearest motorways (A12, A15 and A50).

The nearest railway station is Ede-Wageningen, which is located in the town of Ede. The yellow line is the river Rhine.

3. Location of the office in Wageningen

4. Driving directions

From motorway A12 (The Hague - Utrecht - Arnhem)

- Take exit Wageningen - Bennekom – Ede
- Follow the signs to Wageningen.
- After entering Wageningen, turn right at the first traffic light, into Nijenoord Allee.
- At the next two traffic lights, continue straight ahead.
- At the next traffic light, turn left into Kortenord Allee.
- Continue straight ahead until, after fifty meters, you see the sign “Wageningen Science Park”. Turn right and immediately left.
- Turn the second street right (Nieuwe Kanaal) and you will see the Noldus building in front of you at number 5.

From motorway A15 (Rotterdam - Tiel - Nijmegen)

- Take exit Rhenen – Kesteren
- Follow the signs to Wageningen. Along the way, you’ll drive over the Grebbeberg (=name of a hill) past Ouwehands Zoo and a war cemetery. Continue straight ahead.
- When entering Wageningen, take the second exit on the traffic circle (straight ahead).
- At the first traffic light, turn left into the Costerweg.
- At the next traffic light, continue straight ahead.
- Continue straight ahead until you see the sign “Wageningen Science Park”. Turn left and immediately left again.
- Turn the second street right (Nieuwe Kanaal) and you will see the Noldus building in front of you at number 5.

From motorway A50 (Zwolle - Arnhem - 's-Hertogenbosch)

- Take exit Renkum – Oosterbeek.
- Follow the signs to Wageningen. You enter Wageningen just before passing the Peugeot-dealer at the intersection with traffic lights. Cross this intersection and continue straight ahead.
- At the next three traffic lights, continue straight ahead. Along the way, you'll pass the bus station on the right, after which the street becomes Lawickse Allee.
- At the next traffic light, after the Shell gas station, turn right into Kortenoord Allee.
- At the traffic circle, take the second exit (straight ahead).
- Continue straight ahead until you see the sign "Wageningen Science Park". Turn left and immediately left again.
- Turn the second street right (Nieuwe Kanaal) and you will see the Noldus building in front of you at number 5.

5. Getting there by public transport

The easiest way to travel relatively large distances in The Netherlands via public transport is by train. The nearest railway station is located in the town of Ede, close to Wageningen. At the station where you board the train (e.g. Schiphol airport), purchase a train ticket to Ede-Wageningen. Travel time from Amsterdam Schiphol airport to Ede-Wageningen is less than one hour.

Upon arrival at the railway station 'Ede-Wageningen', locate a taxi outside the train station and ask the driver to take you to Nieuwe Kanaal 5 in Wageningen. From Ede-Wageningen to our office by taxi will take approximately 20 minutes.

You can also take bus 88 (Valleilijn) from Ede-Wageningen train station to the bus stop at Ooststeeg (located on Kortenoord Allee, in sight of the Noldus building). As soon as you arrive at the bus stop, the Noldus building is right in front of you. This bus leaves every ten minutes during regular hours and every fifteen minutes during rush hours.
